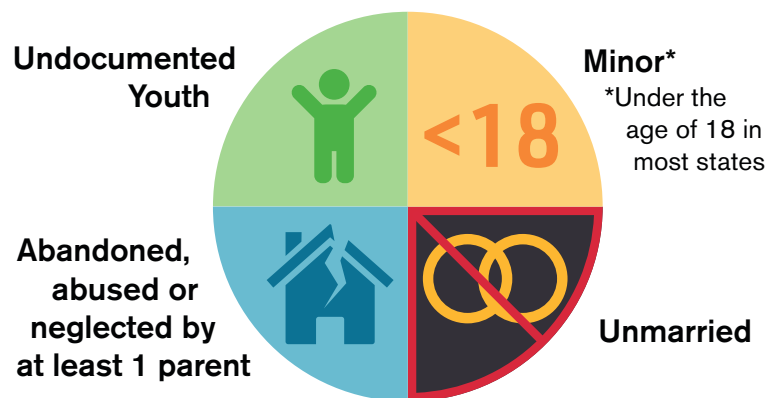


# Immigration Options for Undocumented Youth: **SPECIAL IMMIGRANT JUVENILE STATUS**

## WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS?



**Special Immigrant Juvenile Status (SIJS)...it's a mouthful, right? Well, SIJS is one of the most common immigration options for undocumented youth. Check out the eligibility requirements to see if they apply to you!**

## WHAT DO YOU GET?



### **Work Permit & Social Security Number**

This allows you to work legally in the U.S, open a bank account, etc.



### **Possible Pathway to a 'Green Card' & U.S. Citizenship**

You may be able to live without fear of deportation, travel the world, etc.



### **Access to Public Benefits**

You may become eligible for federal benefits like food stamps and FAFSA.



### **Fee Waiver Available for Work Permit & Green Card Applications**

No out of pocket costs for you!

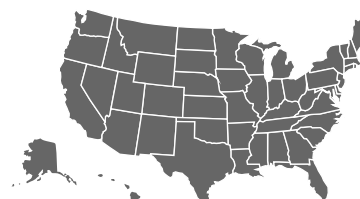
